Enrollment Information

2010-2011

Timeline:

- December 15, 2010: Deadline for returning student applications
- February 26, 2010: New student application deadline
- March 1, 2010: Communication to current families regarding enrollment
- April 2, 2010: Communication to new families regarding admission
- April 30, 2010: Tuition deposit (one month's tuition) to secure spot in fall program

* New student applications will be accepted beyond the deadline as space allows.

Program Descriptions:

Preschool: Preschool is for children aged 30 months - 5 years. The Preschool program is offered daily - families choose the number of days per week for their child. A minimum of three days a week is strongly recommended. Children should be 30 months on or before August 31 for September entry.

Kindergarten/1st : Kindergarten/ 1st grade meets daily Monday through Friday and is geared toward 5 year and 5 year olds who are comfortable communicating in German.

Sibling Discount: A 10% tuition discount applies to the younger child.

Volunteer Requirements:

Families are required to complete 15 volunteer hours per family annually. There are a variety of opportunities to complete these hours both at the school and at home. Volunteer hours assist us in offering a quality program and help to keep the tuition costs low. Additional hours are always welcomed! Families may choose to pay for their hours at \$25 per hour.

Withdrawal /Dismissal:

Enrollment is for the entire school year. A 30-day written notice to the Board of Directors is required when a parent is withdrawing a student during the school year. The tuition deposit is non-refundable. If a 30-day written notice is not given, the entire remaining tuition will be required. SAGA School cannot financially accommodate withdrawals after March 1 except in cases of medical or family emergencies. For any withdrawal after March 1, the entire year's tuition is due prior to the student's last day.

Tuition Payments:

The tuition deposit is considered your September payment and regular tuition payments begin in October 2010. Regular tuition payments are due the 5th of every month. Tuition is based on annual costs per child and is paid in 10 monthly installments from September - June regardless of when holidays, absences and vacations occur. No refunds are offered for missed days.
