SAGA—The Seattle Area German American School is excited to offer a variety of summer programs for children ages 30 months to 10 years old.

Your child (children) will embark on adventures with characters *Pippi Langstrumph* and *Pumuckl*. Together they will explore topics such as fünf Sinne (five senses), Leben im Mittelalter (medieval living), Deutsche Kochkunst (German cooking) and more.
