Our Teachers and Curriculum

The Seattle Area German American (SAGA) School is a German immersion school located in the Greenwood neighborhood of Seattle. We offer programs for Preschool through Elementary School.

Our Grundschule, a certified, non-profit private elementary school, continues a German immersion model, working towards full literacy and truly bilingual students. The Kindergarten year is the first year of formal school and during this year, children learn to read, write, and begin math. In first grade, English is introduced into the curriculum as a subject.

Our teaching philosophy is that students learn best when challenged at the level appropriate to their individual needs. We have worked hard to develop a curriculum that is both rigorous and flexible. We merge the best practices of early childhood education from German-speaking countries with a curriculum meeting Washington State Standards. Our curriculum content prepares children to transfer at a future date into both the German and American school systems.

At SAGA students work independently, with partners, in small groups, and as a whole class. We believe a well-rounded educational experience and varied learning environment is vital to creating great learners. We use the Second Step (Faustlos Program) to teach social skills and problem-solving strategies. Music, art, and sport programs are weaved into daily learning, helping students engage and imagine at all levels.
